

# HUMANITARIAN AWARD

An award for Humanitarian Efforts within a company recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to the welfare of others, showing compassion, empathy, and a commitment to social responsibility. This accolade honors employees who go beyond their professional duties to positively impact their community, society, or environment.

## Key Criteria for a Humanitarian Award:

1. **Community Involvement:** Active participation in charitable activities or community service.
2. **Impact:** Tangible positive effects on the lives of others or the environment.
3. **Compassion and Empathy:** Demonstrating genuine care and concern for the well-being of others.
4. **Initiative:** Taking proactive steps to address social issues and inspire others.
5. **Sustainability:** Ensuring efforts are sustainable and have long-term benefits.
6. **Tenure:** Has been with the company for at least one year.

## Award Benefits:

- **Recognition:** Formal acknowledgment of the individual's humanitarian efforts.
- **Motivation:** Encouragement to continue making a positive impact.

## Examples:

- **Internal Humanitarian** - This award might be given to an employee who has organized a company-wide charity drive or volunteer program. They may have volunteered with CCA, Hope Farms, Pop's Provisions, etc.
- **External Humanitarian** – This person could have volunteered at The Boys and Girls Club, Church, Habitat for Humanity, School, etc.

## Nomination Process:

- ACs, DOs, VPs, RSC staff to nominate **any** employee by writing a brief description of their contributions and impact.
- Deadline to submit is one week once email is sent.
